But it appears those pencilled in to start next Saturday's Champions Cup final have the weekend off.

At the same time, the bench contenders — Ronan Kelleher, Cian Healy, Michael Ala'alatoa, Ryan, Will Connors, Jack Conan, Luke McGrath, Harry Byrne, Keenan/Jimmy O'Brien — are mainly down the start.

Blues boss Leo Cullen rarely does surprises but this is definitely rotation after a fashion as there are 11 players in the squad who were involved in the heavy defeat to Stormers in South Africa a fortnight ago.

Leinster assistant coach Andrew Goodman hinted Keenan and Ryan, and maybe O'Brien, were put in to start rather than be eased in from the bench as they were auditioning for next week in London.

"You want guys to play footy and we know it's important for them to get minutes under their belt," said Goodman.

"You can do all the training you want but you can't replicate the physicality and the decision-making under pressure etc that a game demands."

Immediate

Ulster goals are, indeed, immediate while Goodman suggested Leinster were looking to find some sort of rhythm after a potentially debilitating double-defeat in South Africa.

"We have obviously had some good patches in games, it's probably just the consistency of performance we are striving for, which we know is a massive part of coming out on top of games at the end of the season."

A win would almost certainly gain Ulster a knick-out spot; a Leinster loss would almost certainly

see them lose out on automatic home advantage at the semi-final and final stages.
